



Video Visits in Patient Portal

Video visits are patient portal appointments using videoconferencing technology to allow patients to visit providers live from a distance instead of in-person.

These appointments must be scheduled as video visits by the provider's office.

Prior to attending a video visit appointment determine which communication method (mobile app or computer) you will use. **Video visits are accessed using a computer with internet and a webcam or Memorial Hospital patient portal HealtheLife mobile app.**

Video Visit Using Computer with Internet and Webcam:

1. Log into Memorial Hospital [Patient Portal website](#) on your computer. Note: Internet browser recommendations are below.

2. Click on View Upcoming Appointments.

5. After installing plug-in you must refresh browser by clicking **refresh arrow** in internet browser address bar, or press **F5** key on keyboard.


